

Manual Grading of Quiz in Moodle

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Instructors must manually grade certain types of questions in a Quiz. For example, Moodle cannot grade an Essay question. Use the following steps to manually grade a question.

1. Open Course.
2. Open up the quiz you would like to grade.
3. Open the gear icon menu > Select "Manual Grading" under Results.
4. On the **Manual Grading** window, you can grade one question for all students.
5. On the screen, you will see student responses (See image below). You can add a comment/feedback and score the response based on the number of points the question is worth. **Save** and continue grading.
